[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 09.05.2022 in CM-6917-CWP-2022 in CWP-8573-2022 in case titled as Ajay Sharma vs Haryana Shehari Vikas Pradhikaran and others.

[2] On the asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Sabherwal, Advocate, who is present, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and on instructions from respondent No.1 states that although no intimation of the interim order, Annexure P/1 dated 09.05.2022 in CM-6917-CWP-2022 in CWP-8573-2022 was received by the respondents, yet on learning about the orders today, plot No.3545-M, Sector 57, Gurugram has been reserved for the petitioner during the pendency of CWP No.8573 of 2022 and the same would not be allotted to anybody except in accordance with orders passed in the aforesaid writ petition. The same satisfies, learned counsel for the petitioner who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn.

of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while directing the respondents to ensure adherence to the assurance held out on behalf of respondent No.1 through learned counsel.
