Today, Power of Attorney on behalf of the appellants has been
filed by Mr.Vishwajit Bedi, Advocate, which is taken on the record.

As agreed, as per statements of appellant No.2, learned counsel
for the appellants, learned counsel and representatives of the Insurance
Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹1,50,000/- (₹ One Lakh Fifty
Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is
allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this
appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the
enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1 - Rano wife of late Shri Ramesh
Kumar.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the
Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹1,50,000/- in the name
of appellant No.1 - Rano wife of late Shri Ramesh Kumar with the office of
the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 13.10.2022, in compliance of
this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this
amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of
the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the
cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance

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Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
