This is a petition that has been filed seeking allotment of paddy for custom milling for the Kharif Marketing Season 2022-23.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would submit that as on date, no dues are pending against the petitioner-Mill against any of the procurement agencies and denial of such allotment is arbitrary in nature.

Notice of motion was issued on 30.09.2022 and the matter was posted for hearing on 13.10.2022, on which date, there was a Court holiday and the matter is taken up for hearing today.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.5 and 7 would submit that the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous since the agreement dated 04.10.2022 has already been entered into between the Managing Director, PUNGRAIN, Chandigarh and the petitioner-Mill, wherein the petitioner-Mill has been allowed paddy for custom milling for the Kharif Marketing Season 2022-23.

A copy of the agreement dated 04.10.2022 is made available in Court today and the same is taken on record.

In view of the aforesaid agreement having been entered into between the Managing Director, PUNGRAIN, Chandigarh and the petitioner-Mill, learned counsel for the petitioner-Mill herein does not press the instant writ petition and seeks disposal as such.
