Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CWP-1166-2021, titled as “Dr.Dheeraj Yadav Vs. State of Haryana and others”, dated 13.10.2021, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The writ petition was disposed of with the following directions:-

“In this writ petition, the petitioner has assailed appointment of respondent No.6 as Professor in Community Medicine in the college run by respondent No.5 on the ground that such employment was secured by respondent No.6 was by producing certain bogus and forged certificates.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that on 28.10.2020, a committee had gone into the issue and had recorded a prima facie finding that respondent No.6 had produced a forged experience certificate to secure such appointment. Counsel for the petitioner further contends that petitioner had issued a legal notice on 27.11.2020 to the respondents to take action on the basis of the said report, but no action has been taken by the respondents.

Mr.Ashish Yadav, Addl. A.G., Haryana, appearing for respondents No.1 to 3 and 5, on instructions, states

that within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the said respondents would take appropriate action on petitioner's legal notice dt. 27.11.2020 by taking into account communication dt. 28.10.2020, addressed by respondent No.5 to respondent No.2.

In view of the said statement, writ petition is disposed of directing respondents No.1 & 2 to take appropriate decision on petitioner's legal notice dt. 27.11.2020 by taking into account the above communication dt. 28.10.2020 sent by respondent No.5 to respondent No.2 within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and communicate the same to the petitioner also."

In reply, learned counsel for the respondents on instructions from Mr.Rohit Singla, ADA, Directorate of Medical Education and Research, submits that in accordance with the directions, vide order dated 12.01.2022 a decision has been taken to place respondent No.6 (in writ petition) under suspension and to hold an inquiry.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.
