This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

By means of the instant petition, a direction was sought that the respondent-Authorities shall initiate necessary action on the complaint dated 06.05.2019 filed by the petitioner expressing the apprehension to her life and liberty/property.

During the course of hearing, vide order dated 11.02.2020, a status report was called for from the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala. In compliance of the said order, a status report by way of affidavit of Satinder Singh (PPS) Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala dated 18.03.2020 was filed. The relevant part of the said status report is extracted as under:-

“3. That it is respectfully submitted that application no.67/LPC dated 06.05.2019 and application no.2117-SPC

dated 16.10.2019 were investigated by Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Phagwara, District Kapurthala and submitted final reports dated 19.11.2019 and 20.11.2019. It was concluded that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the present petitioner and it was found that no case was made out. The above said applications arose from a dispute between the petitioner and the private respondents regarding distribution of villages amongst them. That the above said reports have been seen by the answering respondent.

That apart from this vide letter no.4780-R/S.P dated 19.11.2019 of Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Phagwara, District Kapurthala, the Station House Police Station Sadar Phagwara was ordered to initiate preventive proceedings against both the parties. The copy of the report of Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Phagwara dated 19.11.2019 after translation is attached as Annexure R-1/T and that of report dated 20.11.2019 after translation is attached as Annexure R-2/T.

4. That the deponent has great respect for this Hon'ble Court and the Order dated 11.02.2020 have been duly complied with. The Deponent will make sure that all the orders passed by this Hon'ble Court are complied with in future also.”

That in view of the submissions contained in the status report, no further directions are called for. The instant petition is disposed of in view of the averments contained in the status report.

Disposed of accordingly.
