The present application has been filed for preponing the date of hearing in the main writ petition, which is now fixed for 07.11.2022.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection for grant of prayer as made in the present application.

As prayed for, application is allowed. Date of hearing in the main writ petition is preponed from 07.11.2022 to today and is taken up for hearing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was relieved from service of the Extension Lecturer by the respondents on the ground that a regular employee has joined but, after the joining of the said regular employee, the said employee has been transferred to other place and the post once held by the petitioner of Extension Lecturer is again lying vacant. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the Instructions dated 04.03.2020 (Annexure P-2) issued by the respondent-State, the petitioner can be treated as Displaced Extension Lecturer so as to be adjusted on the said post.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 16.11.2021 (Annexure P/6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to decide the said representation keeping in view the Instructions dated 04.03.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 16.11.2021 (Annexure P/6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in her representation, respondent No.3 is directed to decide the representation dated 16.11.2021 (Annexure P/6) keeping in view Instructions dated

04.03.2020 (Annexure P/2) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
