Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 16.03.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, vide which the petitioners have been declared as proclaimed persons in case bearing FIR No.243 dated 01.11.2017, registered at Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

Vide order dated 11.03.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioners were directed to appear before the trial Court and on doing so, they were to be admitted to *ad interim* bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 11.03.2022, the petitioners have appeared before the

trial Court on 11.04.2022 and have already been admitted to the interim bail, after accepting the bail and surety bonds furnished by them.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.03.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.
