Admittedly, the road is already in existence for a period of 30-40 years. The suit filed by the plaintiff for grant of decree of permanent injunction restraining the State of Haryana from taking over the land for construction of road has been dismissed by both the Courts below.

In view thereof, no ground to interfere is made out with the judgments passed by the Courts below while declining the relief of permanent injunction.

However, the appellant alleges that some part of his land has been used for construction of the road. If that be so, the appellant shall have liberty to avail an alternative remedy.

Disposed of accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
