This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 11.

Short reply by way of affidavit dated 20.02.2022 of the Deputy Superintendent, Sub-Division Majitha, District Amritsar (Rural), along with Annexures R-1 to R-IV, already filed in the Registry is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.

Today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel submits that as per the aforesaid short reply, the statements of both the petitioners were recorded on 02.02.2022, wherein they have specifically stated that they have solemnized marriage and filed the present petition but now they do not apprehend any danger from anyone and do not require any police protection, as their families have accepted their love marriage.

Since the petitioners in their statements recorded on 02.02.2022, which are attached with the aforesaid short reply dated 20.02.2022, have stated that now they do not apprehend any danger from anyone and do not require any police protection, no indulgence of this Court is required.
