The petitioners herein have sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.0112 dated 18.09.2021 registered at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana Rural Punjab, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh from the above-said Police Station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 03.12.2021 as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the petitioners have joined in the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required and they are also not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioners by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 03.12.2021, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
