This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 31.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran qua the petitioners vide which the petitioners have been declared proclaimed offender in case FIR No.18 dated 26.01.2019 registered under Sections 302, 307, 341, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

After arguing for sometime and after seeing that this Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter and also in order to avoid an adverse order, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition and states that the petitioners are ready to

surrender within a period of two weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has further made a prayer that in case, the petitioners surrender within a period of two weeks from today and file an application for grant of regular bail after surrender, the same be decided as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of seven days from the date of filing of the said application.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

The petitioners are directed to surrender within a period of two weeks from today.

In case, after surrendering within a period of two weeks from today, the petitioners file an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court is requested to decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of seven days from the date of filing of the said application.
