This petition was filed seeking directions to respondent-authorities to register FIR against the private respondents under Sections 420, 406, 447, 447, 34, 120-B IPC.

The main grievance raised in the petition is that the representation dated 14th August, 2019 made by the petitioner was not considered.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner in spite of two pass overs.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar submits that representation was considered, it was found that the dispute is civil in nature and the same was filed.

In view of the statement made by learned State Counsel, the petition is disposed of.

Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance, if any.
