MAIN CASE

Present writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for quashing of the impugned transfer order dated 03.11.2021 (P-2) qua petitioner.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits at this stage, his client would be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to consider the request for cancellation of aforesaid impugned order in view of health condition of his wife, depicted in the Medical Certificate dated 23.09.2020 (P-11).

Learned State Counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off accordingly.

Needless to say if petitioner shall make a request to the quarter concerned within three days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, necessary orders be passed as per law within one week thereafter.

Also clarified that in case there is a failure, petitioner would be at liberty for revival of this writ petition.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
