Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in Session Case No.19 of 2016, titled as “Rakesh Kumar Versus Tirath Kaur and Others” dated 02.06.2015, in the Court of Ld. Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar (Annexure P-1), registered for offences under Sections 323, 354, 352, 506, 504 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and 3 (x) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station Mukandpur, District S.B.S.Nagar.

Admittedly, the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender. Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Prem Shankar Prasad Versus The State of Bihar and another, 2021 SCC Online Supreme Court 955***, has held that a person, who has been declared as an absconder or proclaimed offender/person is not entitled to the discretionary relief of anticipatory bail.

Petition is dismissed.
