Present petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.5 to 13.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are major and got married on 6.5.2022 against the wishes of respondents No.5 to 12. Thereafter, petitioner No.1-Sunita was abducted by the said respondents and was forcibly married to respondent No.13-Sonu on 19.6.2022; that now respondents No.5 to 13 are extending threats to the petitioners and with regard to the same, representation Annexure P-7 has been submitted to respondent No.2 but the authorities failed to take any action in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Harpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana. She submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in

accordance with law.

In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad to consider representation Annexure P-7 and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
