The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.80 dated 09.10.2021 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC 1860 registered at Police Station City Banga District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been unnecessarily dragged into the FIR in question, which was registered at the instance of his daughter-in-law. Learned counsel further submits that there was a marital discord between the son of the petitioner and his wife i.e. complainant and the allegations levelled in the FIR in question were totally fabricated and false. He submits that pursuant to order dated 30.11.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surinder Kumar does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined the investigation. He, on further instructions states that the petitioner is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 30.11.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
