Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.117 dated 12.05.2021 registered under Sections 452, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (for short “POCSO Act”), however, Section 6 of POCSO Act, was deleted and Section 376-D IPC was added later on, at Police Station Sadar Tauru, District Nuh (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 27.04.2022, petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and has joined the proceedings. She submits that the petitioner has been released on interim bail.

This fact has been verified by State counsel upon instructions from P/SI Sumit.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, order dated 27.04.2022 is made absolute and petition is disposed of.
