SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Malerkotla, District Malerkotla, has been filed. The same is taken on record.
2. The result of the examination, as made by the FSL concerned, reveals, that the cache of the psychotropic substance, as became allegedly recovered from the conscious, and, exclusive possession of the petitioner, did hold the traces, and, ingredients of the psychotropic substance concerned.
3. At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.
4. Leave granted.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
6. However, the learned trial Judge concerned, is directed to conclude the trial, as arises from the petition FIR, within three months from today.
