Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the transfer of the petitioner has been effected without appreciating the fact that declaring the post being occupied by the petitioner as surplus is arbitrary, illegal and contrary to the fact as there are sufficient numbers of students to be taught by the petitioners at her present place of posting.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of filing a representation dated 09.09.2022 (Annexure P-20), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Budhwar, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in

Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection

in deciding the representation dated 09.09.2022 (Annexure P-20) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in her representation, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 09.09.2022 (Annexure P-20) by passing a speaking order within a period of 03 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

In case the petitioner has not been relieved from her present place of posting, she be allowed to continue at her present place of posting till the decision of the representation.

Present writ petition stands disposed off.
