AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to investigate the case in a fair and impartial manner and to conclude the investigation at the earliest.

Status report dated 10.11.2021 by way of affidavit of Sukhbir Singh, PPS, DSP, Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today, is taken on record. Relevant para 5 of same reads thus:-

“That finally, after due investigation of the case, challan against the accused/respondent No.4 has already been presented in the learned trial Court on 07.11.2022 and the charges against the accused/respondent No.4 has also been framed on 07.11.2022 and now the case is fixed for 24.01.2023 for further proceedings.”

In view of the status report, learned counsel for the State submits that this case has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

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Accordingly, no further order is required to be passed in the matter and the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
