MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0124 dated 27.06.2021 under Section 379-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 30.11.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was initially implicated in case FIR No.84 dated 27.06.2021, under Sections 392, 395, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, Patiala, on the basis of disclosure statements suffered by co-accused Baljit Singh, Manpreet Singh and Deep Singh, however, in the said case, concession of interim pre arrest bail was extended to him vide order dated 25.11.2021. He submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in another FIR No.0124 dated 27.06.2021, under Section 379-B IPC registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib, on the strength of the similar disclosure statements made by the said co-accused. He submits that the petitioner is willing to join the investigation.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by ASI Avtar Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 30.11.2021 is made absolute.
