On request, the instant matter taken in Bi-monthly Lok Adalat,
accordingly discussed.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹1,00,000/- (₹ One Lakh Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellants in proportion as already awarded by the MACT.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the appellants to supply their Bank Account Numbers to respondent No.2 -Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Company Limited within one week from today. Pursuant thereto, Insurance Company will deposit the agreed amount in the Bank Account of appellants within three weeks thereafter. In case of failure to provide the Bank details by the appellants, the Insurance Company shall deposit crossed-cheques in the sum of ₹1,00,000/- in the respective names of the appellants in proportion as already awarded by the MACT with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of one month, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall

follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent - Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
