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PANKAJ JAIN, J.(ORAL).

This petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 alleging that the respondents are in contempt of this Court having violated order dated 21.05.2015 passed in CWP No.7540 of 2015 and also order dated 30.11.2015 passed by the Contempt Court in COCP Nos. 2500 and 2694 of 2015 whereby respondents were directed to hold draw of lots upto 31.08.2015 which time was further extended on 31.01.2016.

Mr. Arora would not deny that draw of lots has been conducted. However, he joins issue in submitting that the allotment pursuant to draw of lots has been made illegally and in hostile discrimination to the rights of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the order already stands complied with and nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition. The same has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed off accordingly. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to avail all remedies available to them to pursue their case.
