MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.24 dated 23.04.2021 under Sections 307, 353, 186, 341, 148, 149 and 427 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Kotfatta, District Bathinda, who apprehends her arrest at the hands of Police.

On 01.12.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the allegations against the petitioner are similar, which have been made against co-accused-Babli Kaur and she has been released on anticipatory bail vide order dated 30.07.2021 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion for 08.03.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated herself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by SI Gurminder Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 01.12.2021 is made absolute.
