[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 20.05.2019, in CWP No.13413 of 2019 in case titled as '**Sushma Kumari**versus**Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran and others**.'

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.13413 of 2019 was disposed of vide order dated 20.05.2019 in the same terms as in COCP No.7665 of 2017 in case titled as '**Arun Kumar Arora**versus**State of Haryana and others**', decided on 09.07.2018.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the respondents have passed speaking order dated 08.12.2021, rejecting the claim of the petitioner and that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition as the petitioner has already challenged order dated 08.12.2021 by way of CWP No.6316 of 2022.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner to pursue CWP No.6316 of 2022in accordance with law.
