This is claimants' appeal seeking modification of award
passed by MACT, Panipat.

On request, the instant matter is taken up in Bi-monthly Lok
Adalat, accordingly discussed.

Mr. Sukesh Kumar Jindal, Advocate has given his consent
telephonically to learned counsel for respondent No.2-Insurance Company
regarding settlement of the matter for a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lac
only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal to the appellant
in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Learned counsel for
the appellants has no objection in case the enhanced amount be paid to the
appellants.

Accordingly, we dispose off this case with a direction to the
Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.1,00,000/- in the
name of the appellant with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court
within four weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which,
interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the
date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office
shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned
counsel/representative of the respondent–Insurance Company. The
appellants' counsel/appellants may collect the cheque from the office of the
Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and
file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
