During the course of partition proceedings, mode of partition was approved. The petitioner challenged the same by way of appeal which was allowed. The appellate order was challenged by the private respondents and the same was set aside. Further revision petition filed by the petitioner has failed and thus, the present writ petition has been filed.

As noticed in order dated 27.02.2020, this petition was got listed on 17.02.2020 after mentioning the same. However, learned counsel for the petitioner did not appear on the said date and sought an adjournment. On the next date of hearing, a written request for adjournment was circulated. Today again, a written request for adjournment has been circulated on the ground that the learned counsel for the petitioner is in personal difficulty.

From the aforementioned facts, it is evident that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing this case. It is, accordingly, dismissed for want of prosecution.
