Learned counsel for the petitioners, in the light of the affidavit dated 07.02.2022 of the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Pehowa, District Kurukshetra, states that the present petition can be disposed of in the light of the assertions made in paras 11 and 12 of the said affidavit, which read as follows:-

- “11. That the cases under section 13-A of Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 have not been finalized, hence to avoid multiplicity of the litigation, on the applications being filed, the case were adjourned sine die.*
- 12. That in case this Hon'ble court would so direct, the deponent shall take up all cases for hearing and would proceed with the same in accordance with law.”*

In the light of the above, we dispose of the present writ petition with directions to the competent authority to consider and decide the petition filed under Section 7 (2) of The Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, within a period of three months from today.

In view of the disposal of the writ petition, all pending applications stand disposed of as infructuous.
