Prayer in the applications is for condonation of delay of 53 days in filing the application for review and for reviewing the order dated 08.07.2022.

Learned counsel for the applicant has failed to bring to the notice of this Court any reasonable grounds for delay of 53 days in filing the review application. Therefore, the application for condonation of delay stands dismissed.

Even otherwise, the order dated 08.07.2022 was passed in presence of learned counsel for the applicant and a perusal of the same reveals that at the time of arguments he did not controvert the factum of injured having been permanently incapacitated for life on account of injuries sustained by her in the accident in question. It would be further relevant to point out here that the documents (Annexures A-1 to A-3) being relied upon by the learned counsel were neither led in evidence before the MACT nor were they placed on record by way of additional evidence before this Court during pendency of the appeal, thus, they cannot be taken into consideration at this stage. Hence, in the facts and circumstances as enumerated hereinabove, no ground is made out to review the order dated 08.07.2022.
