This is the first petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.195 dated 10.09.2021, under Sections 307, 459 & 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 302 and 460 IPC have been added later on), registered at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is involved in four other cases, but in para No.16 of the present petition it has been mentioned that the petitioner is not involved in any other case. It is further submitted that the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after mentioning the details of the said FIRs and after giving other relevant facts and further states that in the fresh petition he would also annex reply which has been filed by the State in the present case.

In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
