Vide this application, advancement of the date of hearing in the accompanying petition is sought, which otherwise stands adjourned to 26.05.2022.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner first points out that a similar application was dismissed by this court on 22.12.2021 but with the turn of the case still not having come up again on 13.01.2022.

He next submits that in fact the co-accused of the petitioner already having admitted to bail upon a compromise having reached between them and the complainant.

He points to an affidavit stated to have been executed by the complainant (copy Annexure P-2).

Notice in the application.

On the asking of the court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, A.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the above, the application is allowed and the date of hearing in the accompanying petition is advanced to today itself.

CRM-M-50534-2021

This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 47, dated 24.03.2021, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 379-B/323/427 of the IPC.

A perusal of the orders passed in the case of two co-accused of the petitioner, i.e. Sahil Kumar and Lovekush alias Love Kumar, shows that they were admitted to bail, on the ground of the compromise itself.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
