Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.27 dated 26.3.2022, registered under Sections 376, 420, 494, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Dehlon, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that this is the second petition filed by the petitioner before this Court. Earlier petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 11.7.2022.

After arguing for some time, he fairly submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Court concerned and the said Court be directed to decide his bail application expeditiously.

Finding the prayer made as a genuine one, the petitioner is allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the Court concerned. If the petitioner surrenders and files bail application before the Court concerned within 7 days from today, the trial Court is directed to decide the same expeditiously preferably within a week thereafter.
