AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed seeking directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and her minor children from the hands of private respondent No. 4.

Learned counsel for UT Chandigarh on instructions submits that opinion of the Deputy District Attorney, Legal (DDA) has been received and in view of the opinion received, the matter has been sent to Cyber Cell and an earnest effort would be made to conclude the enquiry within eight weeks and the threat perception of the petitioners would also be considered.

In view of the above, petition is disposed of.

It is clarified that the petitioners in case aggrieved of the result of the enquiry would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Since the main case is disposed of, the pending applications for impleadment, etc. are rendered infructuous.
