This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ especially in the nature of Certiorari for quashing of order dated 25.02.2020 (Annexure P-4), passed by respondent No.1, vide which the petition under Sections 21 & 22 of Punjab Maintenance & Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007 filed by the present petitioner was dismissed.

Pursuant to the previous order, Inspector Yadwinder Singh, SHO is present in the Court and has filed the status report along with copy of receipt of deposit of the costs as Annexure R-6, in the Court. The same is taken on record.

Pursuant to the previous order dated 10.11.2022, the parties are present in the Court and both the counsels, on instructions from the parties, have submitted that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and both the parties are now residing peacefully in the same house.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further with the present case. The present petition is disposed of as having been rendered as infructuous.

However, it is further ordered that in case the petitioner or his wife are again harassed by respondent Nos.2 and 3, then the petitioner would be at liberty to get the present petition revived by moving an appropriate application.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any, is also disposed of as such.
