Challenging the correctness of the judgment passed by Wakf Tribunal, the petitioner has filed the revision petition. A suit filed by the Wakf Board for grant of decree of possession with respect to the land measuring 11 kanals and 3 marlas along with decree of recovery of Rs.6,00,000/- towards use and occupation of the land has been decreed. It is the case of the Wakf Board that the property was leased to Sh. Beant Singh, the petitioner's father on 21.03.1972 for three crop years.

On the other hand, the petitioner claim that the lease was for a period of 99 years.

The petitioner failed to produce the lease deed for a period of 99 years. It has been noticed by the Tribunal that either under the Wakf Act, 1954 or subsequent Wakf Act, the Wakf property cannot be given on lease for a period of 99 years.

Furthermore, the petitioner has failed to produce the alleged lease deed for 99 years.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
