The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0106 dated 15.07.2017 registered under Sections 498-A IPC (challan presented under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC), at Police Station City Batala, district Batala and all proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners, on the basis of a written compromise (Annexure P-2).

On 18.09.2019, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court on 09.10.2019 for recording of their respective statements with regard to the compromise, who in turn was directed to submit a report along with the recorded statements with regard to the veracity of the compromise between the parties.

As directed, report dated 24.10.2019 from the Judicial

Magistrate First Class, Batala has been received, as per which the parties had recorded their statements before the Trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them and that the compromise effected between the parties is genuine and the petitioners have not been declared proclaimed offenders.

Learned State counsel has also raised no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR, which arises out of a matrimonial dispute and the matter having been compromised, would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in ***Narinder Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Anr. (2014) 6 SCC 466***, this Court deems it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash FIR No.0106 dated 15.07.2017 registered under Sections 498-A IPC (challan presented under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC), at Police Station City Batala, district Batala and all proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.
