The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release Rs.1,50,000/- to the petitioner which was approved under the “Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojna” (Housing for All Urban) Vertical-Beneficiary Led Component (BLC) Scheme.

When pointed out, as to whether the conditions as prescribed in the Annexure P-3 have been complied with by the petitioner or not, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly concedes that the same has not been done so far. He thus seeks

permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to all the remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
