Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.251 dated 03.10.2021 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Line Paar, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 02.12.2021: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, two persons, namely Rohit and Mani, were nominated as accused, who have caused injuries to complainant's side.

Learned counsel further submits that after the arrest of the aforesaid persons, the name of the person surfaced in their

disclosure. It is further submitted that the petitioner is a young man and has no such antecedents of involvement in any such or similar matter...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaipal, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 02.12.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
