This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 7 for taking action against respondent Nos.8 to 11 and direct them to conduct enquiry as per law and further direction to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2– Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to consider and decide the representation dated 17.10.2019 (Annexure P-4) and 23.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) (marked to S.H.O. Barnala) alleged to have been submitted by petitioner No.1 seeking protection for his life and liberty along with his family members.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation(s), as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and conveying the same to the petitioners.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
