Vide order dated 14.12.2021, this Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sartaz Singh submits that the petitioner is not co-operating with the Investigator and weapon is yet to be recovered.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would fully co-operate in the investigation. Based on this, he seeks bail.

4. However, learned State counsel submits that in case this Court is inclined to give the bail to the petitioner then it should be subject to the strict and stringent conditions.

5. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 14.12.2021 is hereby made absolute strictly on the condition that petitioner would fully co-operate with the Investigator. Failure to do so shall *ipso facto* result in the cancellation of bail on this ground alone by this Court.
