The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in FIR No. 403, dated 19.05.2022, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 341, 307, 506 and 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (Sections 307 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act have been deleted and Section 326 IPC has been added during investigation) registered at Police Station, Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations qua the petitioner are having given 'gandasi' blow on the head of Sukhpal and his mother, apart from the blow given on the leg of Sukhpal. He relies upon the orders dated 26.08.2022 and 12.09.2022 passed in CRM-M-37117-2022 and CRM-M-40679-2022 respectively, whereby, the co-accused namely Ompal and Harpal have been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court.

The custody certificate of the petitioner filed by the Counsel for

the State is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has

undergone the sentence of 05 months and 20 days by now.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail on the ground that the petitioner was gave a 'gandasi' blow on the head and leg of the complainant and his mother. He, however, could not convert the fact with regard to the custody period undergone by the petitioner.

Considering the facts that the investigation in the present case is complete; no recovery is to be made; challan stands presented; and conclusion of the trial is likely to take time; petitioner is granted bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
