After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, while submitting that the petitioner would surrender before the concerned trial Court within ten days positively and would move an application there for seeking the relief of regular bail and he further prays that the trial Court be directed to decide the bail application of the petitioner within some specific time frame.

Mr. Kunwarbir Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who has appeared in this case in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to respondent-State in advance, has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn with a direction to the concerned trial Court that in case,

the petitioner surrenders before it within the afore-stipulated period and moves any application for seeking the relief of regular bail, the same be decided, strictly in accordance with law, in the given set of the facts and circumstances of the case, within a period of 03 (three) days.
