In compliance of the order passed by this Court on 7th February, 2022, status report by way of an affidavit of Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Sanauli Khurd, District Panipat dated 7th March, 2022 has been received from the counsel for the State of Haryana, which is taken on record. Para Nos. 3 to 6 thereof, read as follow:-

“3. That the deponent submits that on receipt of the copy of the demarcation report the resolution dated 18.02.2022 was passed to file an ejectment application against the encroachers. The concerned Gram Sachiv was authorized through this resolution and directed to file an ejectment application under section 7(2) of Punjab Village Common Land Act, 1961 in the court of Ld. Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum-Sub Divisional Officer (C), Samalkha.

4. That the deponent submits that as per demarcation report an ejectment application, against the 79 encroachers found over the

Khasra No.91 (Firni), have already been filed before the Ld. Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum-Sub Divisional Officer (C), Samalkha on 02.03.2022. Now, the ejectment applications are pending under adjudication before the Ld. Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum-Sub Divisional Officer (C), Samalkha and fixed for hearing on 28.03.2022. Hence, the representation dated 16.11.2021 and 17.11.2021 (Annexure P-2 and P-3) submitted by the petitioner have been duly entertained.

5. That the deponent submits that necessary action, for removal of encroachment against the encroachers, shall be taken in due course of law.

*6. That the deponents submits that the copy of demarcation report dated 04.02.2022, resolution dated 18.02.2022 and the copy of ejectment applications dated 02.03.2022 are attached hereby as **Annexure R-1, R-2 & R-3**, respectively, before this Hon'ble High Court for kind perusal please."*

In the light of above, the present writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

The Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Sanauli Khurd, District Panipat shall continue to supervise the proceedings.
