Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.312 dated 13.06.2019 under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, 1860 (Sections 120-B and 34 IPC and Section 66-A IT Act added later on) registered at Police Station City Sonipat, District Sonipat, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 06.12.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 28.10.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by this Court in CRM-M-44962-2021.

Notice of motion for 28.02.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-44962-2021.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by Inspector Bijender Singh, states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 06.12.2021 is made absolute.
