This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to initiate appropriate legal action against respondents No.5 to 7 involved in causing assault and injuries with intent to kill petitioner after criminally trespassing the agricultural land of the petitioner and also for intimidating him and his family members.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. Ferry Sofat, Addl.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4-State. Copy of the paper book be supplied during the course of the day.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed off only with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to consider and decide the complaint dated 12.07.2021 (Annexure P-1) (marked to SHO, Police Station Jhabbal) and representation dated 14.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off only with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran that if any such representation, as indicated above, are indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and conveying the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
