VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to independently and fairly inquire into the representation dated 26.09.2022 in which the petitioner has sought protection of life and liberty of the petitioner as well as labourers on the averment that he had been given work of handling and transportation contract of food grains at Malerkotla Centre under D.O. Sangrur by the FCI and was being obstructed from doing the said work.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that at the moment his grievance is redressed inasmuch as the work of the petitioner is going on smoothly and thus, necessary action has been taken on his representation dated 26.09.2022. It is submitted that thus, on account of the same, the present petition be disposed of, at this stage, with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition in case any cause of action arises in future.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as

having been rendered infructuous, at this stage. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition in case any cause of action arises in future.

In case the second petition is filed, the same would be considered independently on its merit.
