The learned counsel for the petitioners argues that while working as Extension Lecturers, the petitioners have already enhanced their qualification and have attained the qualification of Ph.D which qualification has already been verified by the respondent-State to be a valid degree but still, the enhanced qualification of the petitioners has not been mentioned on the portal so as to certify that the petitioners are Ph.D degree holders as well as that the petitioners are entitled for the salary of Rs.57,700/- as has been extended to the Extension Lecturers who are qualified as per the prescribed Rules. The learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the respondents are under obligation to update the information of the petitioners qua the MIS portal as well as to grant the petitioners the full salary which they are entitled for from the date the petitioners attained the Ph.D qualification.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of
the State of Haryana. The learned State counsel submits that though, the

present petition has been filed by the petitioners but the grievance as noticed herein before, has not been raised before the respondents and in case any such representation is filed by the petitioners, appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of any such information and in case the grievance raised by the petitioners is found genuine, appropriate relief will be extended to the petitioners within a period of four weeks thereafter.

Faced with this situation, the learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation alongwith the recommendation made by the appropriate authority.

Ordered accordingly.
