Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.128 dated 30.10.2019, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.

The counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the proceedings in the trial Court on the basis of the order of interim bail dated 10.12.2021 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

In support of his contention, the counsel for the petitioner has produced copy of order dated 27.01.2022 wherein also the presence of the petitioner was marked in the trial Court. The counsel for the petitioner further submits that as per his instructions, thereafter, the petitioner is regularly appearing before the trial Court.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh make submissions that the present petition be disposed of, in view of the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner coupled with copy of order

In view of the above, as the petitioner has joined the proceedings with the trial Court, the present petition is allowed and the order of interim bail dated 10.12.2021 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. However, the petitioner should regularly appear before the trial Court on each and every date fixed in the trial.
