By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.PC for seeking the issuance of direction to learned Additional Sessions Judge, Panipat, to decide the application dated 15.11.2019 (Annexure P-4) as moved by him under Section 311 Cr.PC in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.25 dated 31.01.2017 registered at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat, under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 as well as Section 307 read with Section 34 IPC, in a time bound manner.
