Today, at the very outset, learned counsel representing the petitioner has submitted that since identically situated co-accused have been granted concession of regular bail by the trial Court, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file afresh before the trial Court on the grounds of parity.

In view of the aforesaid position, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. Needless to mention, the trial Court shall consider the issue of parity with cases of co-accused, who have been granted bail and shall also take into account the custody period.
